The basic level on which all of us live is that aspect of our lives which permits us to be useful to society and, at the same time, to earn a living.

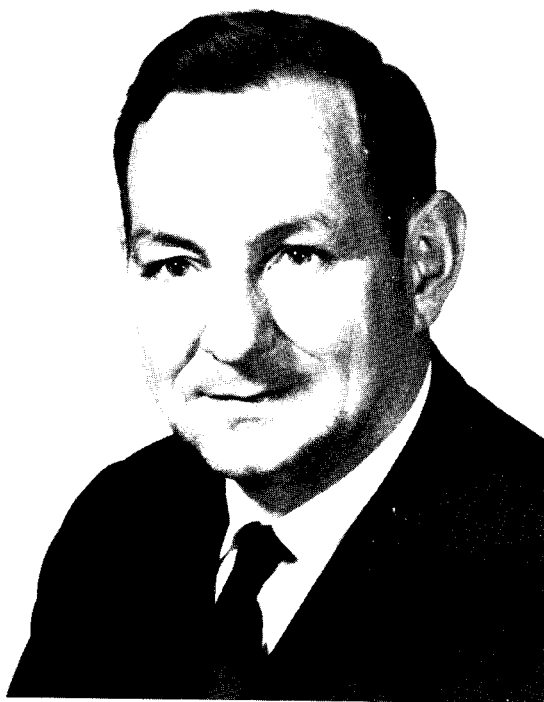
