The Concert band, stage band, and chorus performed at the Officers Club on March 1, 1968, in a special program for German-American culture week.

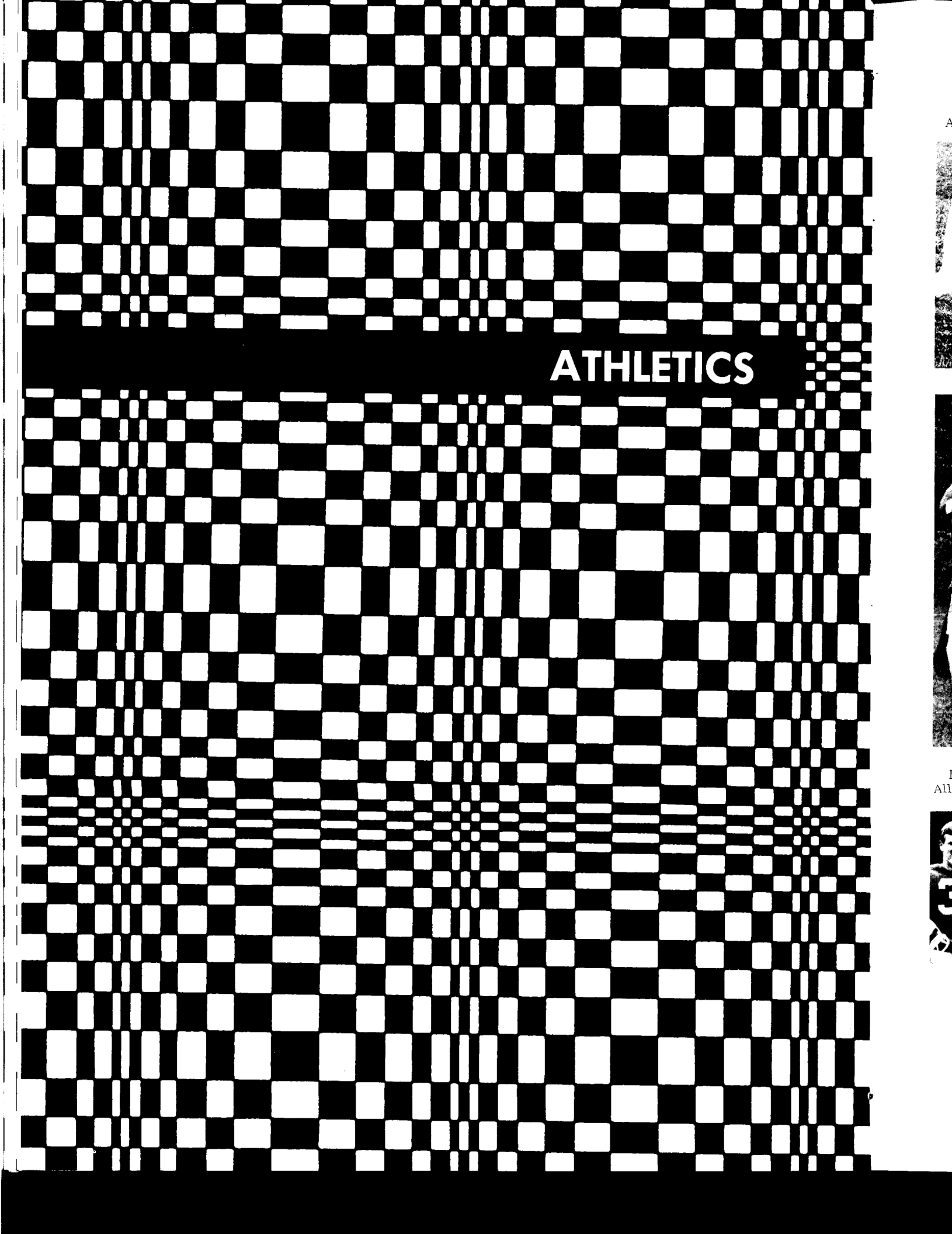

The Annual Spring Concert was planned for April, featuring Concert Band, Chorus, Stage Band, and Soloists.







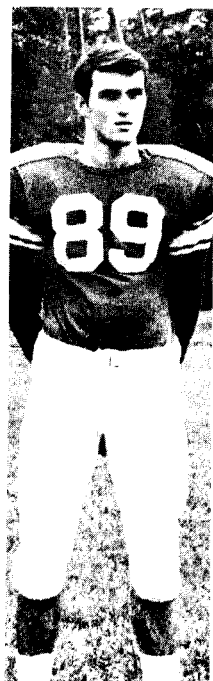
